BABESIA GIBSONI

INTERESTING HISTORY. : In the early 70's a young lady, Aneta Rambo, working for me as a lab tech. Called me over to look at some blood slides with abnormal RBC's. Covered in small blue dots. Unknown condition. Sent copies to my lab (Antech) which could not be identified. Samples given to Dr. Dodds, who also could not identify this organism. She requested samples for University Vet hospitals around the nation. Also negative responses. Except for one. Texas. People around a microscope looking and wondering when along passed a South African Vet who took a look and said " Babesia gibsoni" --- Diagnosis !

Two dogs from the Calif Desert, Bachus road, middle of no where, on an enclosed 5 acre ranch both came down with this disease. Both although treated with a variety of medications --died.

Paper form American Vets in Formosa came up with a treatment. This drug unavailable in the USA. 'Imizol' --Imidocarb dipropionate

My supplier had to have permission from the FDA to purchase this from England and finally get it delivered to my clinic. Began to see many of these cases. How spread? UCD was claiming tick bites. Few to none of these in the high deserts of Calif so vector still unknown.

If caught in time and identified and not confused with Hemolytic anemia then could be effectively controlled and cured.

My understanding is that this disease is now spreading rapidly across the USA.

Imidocarb is now available in the USA and works just fine for treatment.
